Construction Workers Die Each Year from Hazards Associated with Aerial Lifts!

Common Aerial Lift Fall Hazards

- Falls from an elevated level
- Falling objects from lifts
- Tip-overs
- Ejections from the lift platform
- Structural failures (collapse)
- Electric shock/ electrocution
- Entanglement
- Contact with objects
- Contact with overhead objects

*Wearing personal fall arrest systems
can greatly reduce your risk
of death from these hazards!*
