## Residential Trigger Heights Requiring Fall Protection in Kentucky

### 10 FT. TRIGGER HEIGHT

When exposed to any of the following:

- Unprotected sides and edges
- Leading edges
- Hoist areas
- Form work and reinforcing steel
- Roofing on slopes of 3 in 12 or less

### 6 FT. TRIGGER HEIGHT

When exposed to ALL other residential construction activity.

If the activity is not listed in 803 KAR 2:412, then 29 CFR 1926.501(b)(1)-(12) and (b)(14)-(15) apply.
