This is a full-time position and appointees shall not hold any other public office or maintain any private practice.

Applicants for the position must be a licensed attorney for a minimum of eight (8) years and must have the qualifications required of an Appeals Court Judge, except for residence in a district, and shall receive the same salary and shall be subject to the same standards of conduct.
